Coral Ridge Removed Elder and Apologized on Sunday for Handling of Tullian Tchividjian Affair, Sources Say Update March 23, 2016, 2:30 p.m. ET:

In a statement to The Christian Post Tuesday, a spokesperson for Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church said former Pastor Tullian Tchividjian recently confessed that two laypeople who served as elders were made aware of his affair in 2014 by a friend of the pastor. One elder who was still a member of the church admitted he acted on outside counsel and failed to report the events to Tchividjian's family, church leadership and the other elders. The layperson has subsequently submitted his resignation."

Tullian Tchividjian Confesses Second Affair Concealed by Two Coral Ridge Elders

"This weekend, Tullian Tchividjian's past two churches confirmed rumors that the Florida pastor had another affair prior to the one that prompted his resignation last summer.

But the pastor who gave Billy Graham's grandson a second chance says he doesn't regret it.

Last Wednesday, CT reported how Tchividjian was fired following fresh “disclosures.”

“Repentance is progressive and often painful,” both Willow Creek Presbyterian Church and Tchividjian separately told CT. “It involves disclosing and dealing with the darkest places of our hearts and lives.”

“I remain committed to that painful and progressive process,” Tchividjian told CT.

On Monday afternoon, he publicly apologized for the pain he has caused his family.

“I hope and pray that the events in my own life over the past couple years serve as a warning to all who, like I did, believe they are standing firm,” stated Tchividjian. “Sin is deep. It is real. It destroys. It deceives. May this be an opportunity for all of us to examine our own hearts and beg God for the mercy and forgiveness we all need...”

Coral Ridge Elders Knew of Tullian Tchividjian's Affair With Married Woman, Advised Him to Keep Secret, Source Alleges

“... Tullian had actually been confronted about that two years ago. At the time, he was confronted by two elders at Coral Ridge and Steve Brown (Key Life Ministries), and confessed to having a relationship with a married woman,” said the source.

“At the time, he was not advised to step down as lead pastor, but instead was advised not to immediately inform his wife about the matter — she only learned about this last week. To make matters worse, the two elders never informed the rest of the session about this situation. One can only wonder whether the second situation could have been averted if the first situation had not been covered up,” the source continued.

“This is not a situation that Tullian had kept quiet and suddenly disclosed to someone for the first time last week. It’s been known by at least three others in addition to Tullian and the woman involved for over two years,” the source added...”

Willow Creek Fires Tullian Tchividjian After He Confesses to Another Affair

“Willow Creek Church in Winter Springs, Florida, confirmed Thursday that they have fired Tullian Tchividjian, 43, grandson of evangelical icon Billy Graham, after he revealed a previously unconfessed affair he had with another woman.

"When we heard the disclosures he made just a few days ago, the session acted within hours to end his employment at the church," Willow Creek's Senior Pastor Kevin Labby told *The Christian Post* in an interview Thursday morning."

Key Life Founder Steve Brown: Tullian Tchividjian Confessed Affair to Me But Didn't Take My Advice

"Steve Brown, founder of Key Life Network, which preaches the "ministry of Jesus is the radical grace of God," said this week Tullian Tchividjian, former Coral Ridge pastor and grandson to evangelist Billy Graham, confessed his adultery to him and he gave him advice that wasn't followed.

"I hate what happened to Tullian's family, Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church, Willow Creek Church, and others who have been hurt. If I knew how to fix it, I would. I've read the reports in the media about the situation and some of the comments about me. I'm quite uncomfortable in defending myself and even more uncomfortable talking with anybody about this situation. However, I do need to say something," Brown began in a post on his website.

"The Christian Post previously reported that Tchividjian confessed to engaging in an adulterous affair with a married woman in 2014, which led to him being fired recently from Willow Creek Church in Winter Springs, Florida.

"He landed the job at Willow Creek last September, two months after he resigned from Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church after confessing to another extramarital affair. During that period he filed for divorce from his now ex-wife, Kim, and was deposed of pastoral credentials by the South Florida Presbytery.

"Two other elders at Coral Ridge are said to have withheld Tchividjian's 2014 indiscretions after being informed of his failings. At least one of the elders has stepped down because of the controversy. Brown was also counseling Tchividjian at the time...

"If you ever need to tell someone safely about your sins, I'm the guy. I don't talk in my sleep, never tell others, and will go to my grave with more secrets people have told me than you would believe. The church really isn't a very safe place. I wish it was, but it isn't. So most of us hide the reality of who we are, what we've done, and the shame we feel. I wanted people (including pastors) to have at least one place where they could feel safe and could deal with their sin and shame. I was that for Tullian," he continued..."
